Microsoft Exchange 2007

- Integrated email, calendar, contacts, etc.
- Outlook, Outlook Web Access or Entourage for integrated experience
- Authentication via Penn AD domain accounts
- Sync w/Windows Mobile devices

Microsoft Exchange 2007

- Spam filtering & virus scanning
- User@upenn.edu forwarding
- Quota: 250 MB
- Cost: \$90/year
- Uptime: targeting 98.5% first year

Other Options

- **Pobox Classic**
 - \$42/yr Basic, \$36/yr Enhanced (PennKey authN)
 - 250 MB quota
 - Virus scanning & spam filtering
 - User@upenn.edu forwarding
- Additional quota (either): 250 MB @ \$12/yr
- User@upenn.edu forwarding (à la carte):
\$17.86/yr
 - Includes virus scanning & spam filtering
 - Pending community interest (thoughts?)

Wireless PDA Sync

- Cost: \$120-180/yr (TBD based on interest)
- Tentative service possibilities:
 - Pobox Classic: email sync for Palm & Windows Mobile
 - Meeting Maker: calendar sync for Palm & Windows
 - Exchange: email + PIM sync for Blackberry (Windows Mobile bundled w/Exchange account)

Project Schedule

- Internal pilot: January
- Prepare service: Spring 2007
 - Installation, configuration, development
 - Testing (load, failover, recovery)
 - Documentation
- Customer pilot: late Spring 2007
- Production rollout: July 1, 2007
