

Which of these statements would you agree with?

1. We should subsidize and/or mandate use of ethanol in automobiles to reduce oil consumption.
2. We should subsidize hybrid vehicles because they run on electricity instead of oil.
3. Someone buying a hybrid Prius (compact) is doing more to prevent global warming than someone buying a hybrid SUV.
4. Switching cars to electricity instead of oil will reduce carbon dioxide output.
5. A practical hydrogen-fueled car would nearly eliminate CO₂ emission from transportation.
6. We should switch electricity generation to coal because we have a much larger, more reliable supply than natural gas.
7. We should use "clean coal" instead of regular coal.
