Meredith B. Rosenthal, Ph.D. is Associate Professor of Health Economics and Policy in the Department of Health Policy and Management at the Harvard School of Public Health and a 2006 Sloan Industry Fellow. Dr. Rosenthal received her Ph.D. in health policy at Harvard University in 1998. Her research examines the design and impact of market-based health policy mechanisms, with a particular focus on the use of financial incentives to alter consumer and provider behavior. She is currently working on a body of research that examines alternative models for reforming physician and hospital payment. Specific empirical projects include evaluations of several Patient-Centered Medical Home pilots, pay-for-performance initiatives, and an episode-based payment system.
