Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs (CFLs)

Cell phones & cell phone batteries

NO incandescent light bulbs

NO holiday lights or tubing

All dry cell batteries:

Alkalines (AAA, AA, C, D, 9 volt, 6 volt)

Lead Acid (gel-cell batteries)

Lithium (found in most electronics)

Nickel-Cadmium (rechargeable batteries)

Nickel Metal Hydride (from cordless tools)

Mercury (button cell batteries)

DO NOT PLACE BROKEN CFLs OR LEAKING BATTERIES INTO THE BUCKETS.
